 The ETH notes the complaint of Dr Rad Kadengal, on behalf of his minor son, accusing the English Chess Federation (ECF) of a contravention of section 2.2.7 of the FIDE Code of Ethics, to wit, a gross or repeated violation of the FIDE laws of chess, based upon the ECF's endorsement
