during the meeting held in Athens on 12th - 15th of December 2014, made the following -

DECISION

<u>Case n. 6/2014</u>: "Complaint of the Romanian Chess Federation concerning the cheating case of the Dutch player, Mr Wesley Vermeulen in the 2014 lasi Open, Romania"

- The ETH reaffirms that the case is receivable against Mr Wesley Vermeulen, for an alleged violation of par. 2.2.5 of the FIDE Code of Ethics, as previously decided at the ETH meeting in Athens, June 2014.
- 2. The ETH finds that Mr Wesley Vermeulen, made himself guilty of cheating in his game against GM Vladislav Nevednichy during the lasi Open on 15 May 2014 by using chess software installed on his mobile phone for analysis of the game in progress.

3. The ETH <u>unanimously</u> **rules** that:

3.1 Mr Wesley Vermeulen violated par. 2.2.5 of the FIDE Code of

Ethics.

3.2 Mr Wesley Vermeulen is sanctioned with a worldwide ban of one

(1) year, from 1 January until 31 December 2015. During this

period Mr Vermeulen is prohibited from participating in a chess

competition, or any in any chess-related activity as a player,

arbiter, organiser or representative of a chess federation.

4. The ETH requests the FIDE Secretariat to communicate the decision to

Mr Wesley Vermeulen, the Romanian and Dutch Chess Federations and

the relevant FIDE Commissions and to publish the decision on the FIDE

website.
